There's always something interesting to find in the garden – especially at this time of the year. See if you can find any of these – some of them are really special things to find, so I've put a star next to those and if you find one let me know! My address is lucy@gltc.co.uk

- Ladybird*** How many dots can you see on its back? I hope there are plenty in your garden because they help keep your plants healthy by eating lots of garden pests!
- Stag beetle*** Is it a boy or a girl? The boy one has big pincers at the mouth!
- Dandelion** This looks like one big flower but can you see that it is actually lots of tiny flowers?
- Cuckoo Spit** You'll find this froth on plant stems (I always see it on my Lavender) and it is there to protect the larvae (babies) of insects called Froghoppers!
- Slug** These slimy creatures eat all the leaves on your plants! The biggest one is grey with black spots, the most common one is black with an orange tummy.
- Wood Louse** Lift up a flower pot, you're sure to find some there.
- Caterpillar** Do you know what it will turn into?
- Brightly coloured flower** Flowers are these colours so that they can attract bees
- Stone or pebble in a funny shape** What does it look like?
- Feather** What colour is it? Do you know what sort of bird it belonged to?
